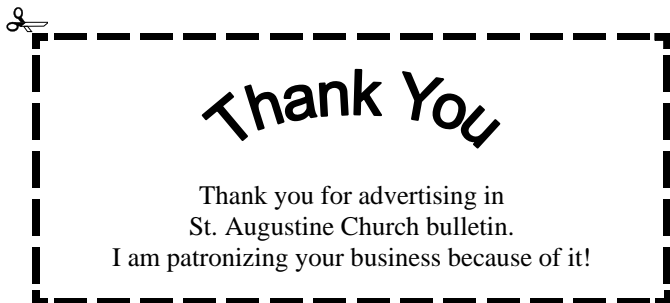
**Note to our envelope users...**
