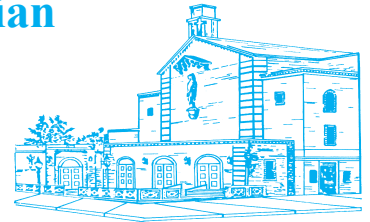

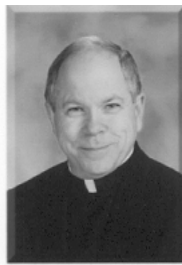

THE PASTOR'S COLUMN



Happy Mother's Day to all of you who are moms, grandmoms, or have stood in the role of a mother for one of us, your sons! Today we will extend a special blessing to all of our Mothers, because they have been such a special blessing to us.

This Thursday is the celebration of the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord, forty days after Easter. It is a Holy Day of Obligation in the United States and Catholics are expected to attend Mass as they do on Sundays. If you're in Woodside, we have Mass on Wednesday and Thursdays evenings at 7:30pm and our regular 7, 9, and 12 Noon on Thursday. If you're in Manhattan, I'm sure that there is a Church convenient to where you work; if elsewhere you can probably find a Church nearby.

It's hard for me to believe that Pentecost is two weeks away! Where did the Easter Season go?

Tomorrow is the feast of St. Mathias, chosen by the Holy Spirit to replace Judas, the betrayer. Think for a moment how he must have felt when the lot fell to him (being chosen by lot was the way the other Apostles understood the working of the Holy Spirit). His whole life and life's purpose changed in an instant by drawing the short straw! It's not really that different for us, as the Holy Spirit tries to move us in a particular direction, but we resist because we don't want our lives upended. "We've made plans" and the Spirit may mess them up, as far as we're concerned and we won't be able to do what we want to do. Surrender to the movement of the Spirit is a life-task that is very difficult to learn. I like to think that I'm in charge, after all I'm an adult not a child. Hmmm "Let the little children come to me.... it is to just such as these, that the Kingdom of Heaven belongs."

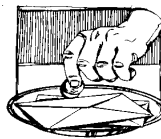

VI DOMINGO DE PASCUAS



Las lecturas de hoy nos han centrado claramente en la consigna del amor como el programa prioritario de los cristianos. Como si la Pascua, que estamos celebrando, tuviera aquí su clave principal: ¿amamos o no amamos? Este es el “mandamiento” por excelencia, que nunca acabamos de aprender y cumplir. No está mal que nos miremos a

este espejo y nos examinemos, para saber si estamos siguiendo bien los caminos del Resucitado.

El Cristo de la Pascua, el entregado a la muerte y resucitado a la vida, es el que puede hablar de amor. En la misma escena en que dice estas palabras -su cena de despedida- hará con sus discípulos un adelanto simbólico de su entrega en la cruz: se ciñe la toalla y les lava los pies. El amor del que sirve, del que se entrega hasta el final, del que no se busca a sí mismo.

* Y ahora viene la conclusión. *Amaos unos a otros*: Es el tercer momento de esta propuesta del amor. Una conclusión que parece como que rompe la lógica, porque se podría suponer que acabara de otro modo: si Dios os ama, si yo os he demostrado mi amor, responded vosotros con vuestro amor a Dios y a mí. Y sin embargo, la conclusión de Jesús es otra: “Amaos unos a otros”. Es una lógica sorprendente, pero que Juan subraya una y otra vez. Sólo el que ama a los demás “ha nacido de Dios”, sólo el que ama “conoce a Dios”.

El día 15 de mayo los campesinos de Ichocán, Perú adornan sus yugos, y las puertas de sus casas con el fruto de sus cosechas en honor a San Isidro Labrador. Muchos países Latinoamericanos celebran esta fiesta. En un continente donde la agricultura es tan importante no hay que sorprenderse de la importancia de este santo español del siglo XII. Además San Isidro se parece a mucha gente de Latinoamérica: es de padres campesinos, de familia pobre y religiosa, no fue a la escuela, quedó huérfano y se empleó como peón de campo, ayudando en la agricultura.

Se casó con María la cual también llegó a ser Santa. Tuvieron un hijo. Los tres fueron reconocidos como piadosos y generosos. Gracias a Dios, la santidad se encuentra en todo tipo de persona. Los casados y padres y madres de familia también llegan a ser santos. Después de su muerte en 1130 se descubrió que su cuerpo estaba milagrosamente incorrupto. En 1622 el Papa canonizó a este humilde campesino junto con algunos grandes religiosos como Santa Teresa, San Ignacio, y San Francisco Javier.


